Tenders for October 26 – November 1: care home for the elderly, heating networks of the Ministry of Defense and other heat and water supply facilities

Over the past week, the website torgi.gov.ru published 19 concession tenders with a total investment of at least 8.3 billion rubles. The average implementation period is 14 years. By the number of lots, Ivanovo region is in the lead (3 lots). 1 project is presented in the social sphere, the rest in the utility and energy sector. 7 of 19 published projects were initiated by a private investor.

The PPP in sports allows attracting of 4.5 private per 1 budget ruble

According to Deputy Minister of Sports Azat Kadyrov, the mechanism of public-private partnership in sports allows to attract 4.5 rubles of private ones for 1 budget ruble. "This is a fairly good, interesting indicator that allows the state to stimulate the development of this institution in future," Azat Kadyrov stressed. He noted that within the framework of the federal target program for the development of physical culture and sports, which ends this year, a separate mechanism was provided, a separate line of financing for projects with the involvement of private partners, which made it possible to start the implementation of 13 facilities.

PPP and investment news

A rope way is planned to be built in Perm by the Public Private Partnership (PPP)

In Perm, it was planned to build an aerial metro in the format of rope way lines based on the PPP. The proposed concept of the project in Perm includes the construction of six rope way stations, and the total length of the network is 3.55 km. Under the concession agreement, the region can also provide land plots for the construction of stations and poles. According to calculations by the Center for Economic Development of RF, the estimated cost of building the rope way in the Perm landscape will amount to 1.27 billion rubles. The occupancy rate of the rope way in Perm is estimated at 3.6–3.7 million passengers per year.

Astrakhan region plans to build a wind farm for 30 billion rubles

The Wind farms FRV company intends to build a wind farm in the Chernoyarsk district of the Astrakhan region in 2022 with an investment volume of 30 billion rubles. Commissioning of the facility is scheduled for 2022. The investor received permits for the construction of facilities, formalized contracts for the assignment of rights to the land plots. The number of stages, as well as the construction area, will be determined by the investor after the start of construction and installation work.

To renew the electric transport of Izhevsk the authorities of Udmurtia intend to attract 19 billion rubles

In the next two years, it is planned to start modernizing the electric transport park in Izhevsk. For this, the authorities of Udmurtia intend to attract about 19 billion rubles. The urban transport renovation project is highly likely to be implemented. Perhaps we will postpone it from 2021 to 2022 due to the economic situation, Vnesheconombank supports us. The project involves a burden on the budget of Udmurtia. It will be of 180 to 360 million rubles.

A new gerontological center will open in Moscow by 2022

By 2022, a new gerontological center will open in Moscow for the elderly residents of the capital. The volume of investments for its creation and equipment will be about 500 million rubles. The city plans to conclude a concession agreement with the winning investor for 20 years. According to the conditions of qualification, the participants must meet a number of criteria, including the availability of financial resources and experience in implementing similar projects. The preliminary stage of the open competitive tender has already been completed. The tender winner will undertake the reconstruction of the building, as well as its equipment, maintenance and repair. The area of the future center is 3,200 square meters. The center provides a minimum of 100 places for permanent residence of patients. There will also be a hospital for a day stay, where special meals, escorts and classes aimed at maintaining cognitive status will be carried out.

The launch of a feed-milling plant in the Novosibirsk region was postponed to 2021

Due to the pandemic, Sibirskaya Niva company (part of Econiva-APK holding) postponed the launch of a feed-milling plant in the Maslyaninsky district of the Novosibirsk region to mid-2021. Investments to the project should amount to about 280 million rubles, the company will produce up to 10 tons per hour of loose compound feed and up to 2 tons of granulated feed per hour. Currently, investments have increased from 280 million to 335 million rubles.

The construction of a 68-storey tower in Moscow City is scheduled to be completed in November

Specialists are completing the construction of a 68-story tower in the Moscow International Business Center "Moscow City," they plan to finish the work in November, this is the second stage of the Neva Towers skyscraper. The facility is being built on Krasnopresnenskaya embankment, plot 17–18 of the Moscow City Moscow International Business Center at the expense of the investor. The complex consists of two towers with a height of 68 and 79 floors united by a four-storey stylobate and a four-storey underground part. Building area is 357 thousand sq. meters, height is 345 meters. The high-rise buildings will house offices and apartments. The project provides for the creation of 2,040 parking spaces. Last year, the first phase of the project was put into operation – a 79-storey skyscraper with four underground floors, where a parking lot for 1,701 vehicles is located.

Solar power plants may appear in the Rostov region

Investors are exploring the possibility of building solar power plants in the Rostov region. Now, the region is actively building wind power plants (WPP). This year, the first three wind farms with a total capacity of 300 MW were built. By the end of the year, Enel Rus Wind Azov plans to complete the construction of the Azov WPP with a capacity of 90 MW. The construction of the first stage of the Cossack WPP with a capacity of 100 MW is at the final phase. The completion of the second stage of construction is scheduled for 2021. In total, it is planned to build eight wind farms in the Rostov region by 2023 with a total capacity of more than 700 MW. Investments in the industry will amount to more than 60 billion rubles.
